







Guide to Selected Chilean Defense Websites

The Chilean defense establishment consists of military and civilian institutions, many of which have their own websites featuring institutional services, news, and academic reports. Many academic contributions on defense issues are featured on these sites. Defense blogs and some related websites also carry unofficial information on Chilean military issues. A few sensitive defense institutions, including intelligence services and related industries, do not have their own websites. An appendix explains the Chilean defense structure.

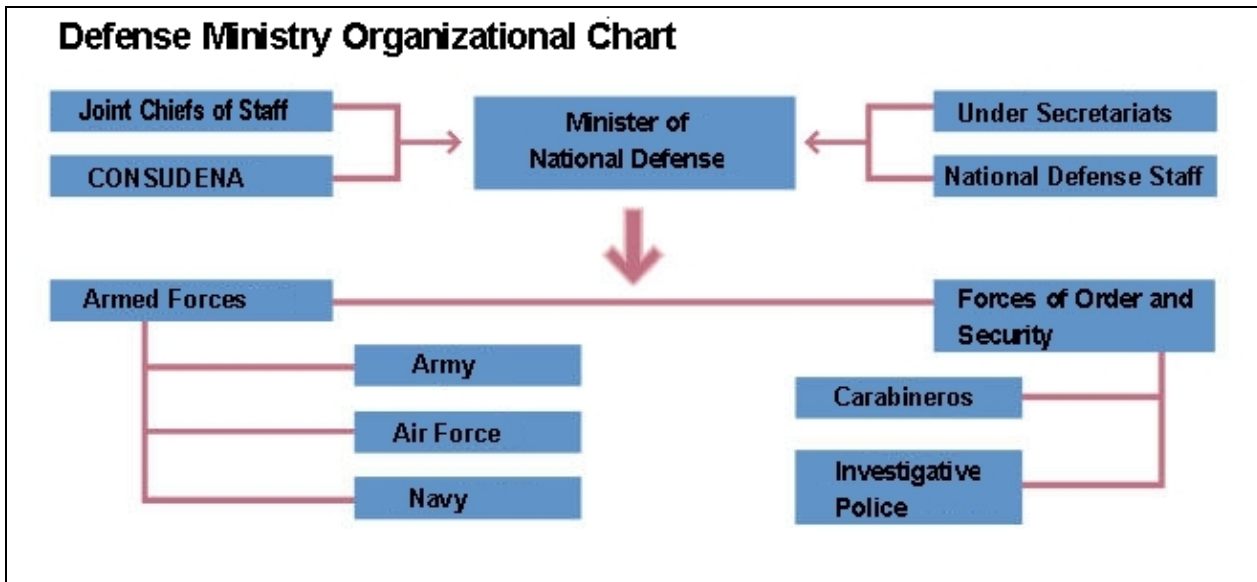

Appendix

The Chilean defense system is organized under the Ministry of Defense, which has authority over the Armed Forces and forces of order. It includes advisory entities such as the National Defense Staff (EMDN), the Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCJ), and the Superior Council of National Defense (Consudena).

- Consudena is made up of the minister of foreign affairs and the minister of finance, as well as the commanders of the Armed Forces. To view a complete description of the Chilean Defense Ministry, double-click on the following icon: 
- The Carabineros and Intelligence Police are subject to the Interior Ministry, which also coordinates all military intelligence services through the National Intelligence Agency (ANI).
- In addition, each Armed Forces branch has its own administrative secretariat, which manages military social security, salary, and similar issues, with its own website (not included in this paper).
