A-7 FROM: Secretary of State ANTIMASSY, MANEY Reference is made to Embassy's Telegram 65 of September 26, 1961 requesting information on members of Soviet Commercial Mission, A check of the biographic files of the Washington intelligence community ICA reveals the following information: Petr Akimovich Zakharikhin served as both chief (1958-59) and assistant chief (1960) of the Soviet Commercial Mission in Morocco where he was involved in real estate purchases for the Soviet Union. He allegedly urged that part of the profits made by Moroccans on the transactions be divorted to the local Union Nationale des Force Populaires (UNFP), a left-wing political party. Zakharikhin acted as Assistant Commercial Counselor at the Soviet Embassy in Paris from 1951 to 1953 where he was suspected of being connected with intelligence activities. He is married, has two children, and reportedly speaks French. In January 1952 Apatoliv Below was reported to be a legal consultent with the Main Administration for Soviet Property Abroad (GUSILZ) in Hungary and also a military interpreter in the Soviet Army reserves with the rank of junior lieutenant. When he graduated from the law Faculty of the Institute of Foreign Trade in Moscow, in 1950, Below was described as a bachelor earning an "average" income and as a diligent but avaricious Komsomol member. 

1. On 5 August 1955, the British Military Attache to Afghanistan told the Army Attache that he had "definite information" to the effect that

Colonel I.I. VOICHODAEV (the Assistant Soviet MA) is engaged in espionage activities in Afghanistan. The British MA did not reveal his source for this information, nor did he give the Army Attache any other details. He stated the information was being furnished in strict confidence so that the Army Attache could follow it up utilizing his own source.

3. As was indicated in our letter, S-2-55, dated 24 March 1955, subject: Social Relations with Soviet and Soviet Orbit Officialdom (U), information is available to the effect that Colonel Volchodaev was engaged in espionage activities while stationed with the Military Attache office in Teheran and it appears not unlikely that he would be assigned similar duties in this area. Further information will be forwarded if and when obtained.

S This office has no information on samuggling activities, espionage rings or any other organized operations directed at Kagnew Station. From time to time the Russian Military Attaches have indicated interest in Kagnew Station, but there is no indication that they have succeeded in these attempts.

It must be assumed that these officials are active in furthering the interests of the Soviet Government here. The Military Attache has shown increasing interest in countries peripheral to Ethiopia since his return from Moscow in the Summer of 1957. The Assistant Military Attache is apparently concentrating on Ethiopia proper. The Military Attaches of the Soviet Embassy have made several attempts to participate to a greater extent in the social life of Addis Ababa. They also have used the cocktail party-movie show evening as a means to approach Ethiopian officials. In other areas the Soviets have stepped up slightly their attempts at economic and cultural approaches to the Ethiopians. For example, they have increased the number of invitations to Ethiopians to visit Russia. They are reported to have made offers of economic assistance to the Ethiopian Government and on one occasion; utilizing the Czechs, they are reported to have offered Air Force assistants.

3. Perhaps the greatest advances by a communist nation in the penetration of Ethiopia have been made by the Tugoslav Government. Slavko Fecevic, Counsellor of Embassy, is the head of the Yugoslav communist party in Ethiopia. He is reported, also, to have attempted to form a party here and to recruit Ethiopians. Hembers of the Yugo-Ethiopian Company are also reported to be active in the Yugoslav communist party. The Yugoslavs recently received a contract to develop the port of Assab and have been rumored to be investigating the possibilities of improvements in the port of Massawa.
